



ST. MICHAEL'S EPISCOPAL SCHOOL ADMISSION CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in St. Michael's Episcopal School. Provided below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission.

Middle School: Grades 6-7

<input type="checkbox"/> Application First round priority deadline is Jan 25, 2023	Complete the online application found on our website: stmschool.net/admissions/process/#process <i>\$50 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Transcript Release Form	Complete and sign the Transcript Release Form . St. Michael's will request Transcripts and a Teacher Recommendation directly from your child's current school in January.
<input type="checkbox"/> Testing Preference Form	Complete the Testing Preference Form . This form will indicate where you wish to have your child's WISC-V testing done. The WISC (<i>Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children</i>) is an individual assessment, administered by a licensed psychologist, that measures cognitive abilities for children.
<input type="checkbox"/> WISC-V Cognitive Abilities Testing	Schedule your child's WISC-V* testing. The WISC may be scheduled at St. Michael's for a fee of \$150, another participating independent school, or privately through a practitioner of your choosing.
<input type="checkbox"/> Visit Day and Skills Assessment	Our team will work with your family to schedule a visit for your child. These visits typically start at the beginning of January. During this all-day visit, your child will be matched with a student host and have the opportunity to experience a day in the life of a St. Michael's student, and learn more about the School. Your child will also complete a grade-level academic assessment as part of the visit.
<input type="checkbox"/> Immunization Record	Submit a copy of your child's Immunization Record. St. Michael's Episcopal School requires that all enrolled students be currently vaccinated as prescribed by the Commonwealth of Virginia without regard to religious exemption.

Initial admission decisions for Middle School applicants are made by March and continue on a rolling basis as space permits. We recommend that all steps and forms be completed by February 23, 2023, to be considered in this initial round of decisions.
