First Grade Supply List

- 2 folder with pockets
- 1 large eraser
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 box (8) washable markers (broad-tip)
- 1 box (8) washable markers (fine-tip)
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 book bag (suggest no wheels)
- 1 lunch box with individual hand sanitizer (to be kept in lunch box)
- 2 snapshots or school pictures (small) that we may keep
- 1 small baggie of coins (to be used for math and returned at the end of the year) – 10 pennies, 5 nickels, 10 dimes, and 4 quarters
- 1 ***large*** box of tissues

Second Grade Supply List

- 1 **wide-rule** spiral notebook with at least 1 pocket divider
- 3 folders with inside pockets
- 2 marble composition book (at least 100 pages, wide rule)
- 2 red ink pens
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 box of thin watercolor markers
- 1 box of thick watercolor markers (maximum of 8 in each box)
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 large container of Clorox wipes
- Girls: one box Ziploc sandwich bags
- Boys: one box Ziploc gallon bags

- 1 book bag (backpack)
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 dozen #2 pencils – **already sharpened**

Third Grade Supply List

Please bring all supplies on the first full day of school. No supplies need to be brought on orientation or registration day. Please put your name on all of your supplies.

- 1 Three ring notebook, no larger than 1 ½ inch thickness because it needs to fit in your desk. No notebooks that zip – they do not fit in the desks.
- 2 – packages Wide ruled notebook paper
- 3 - 8"x11" spiral notebooks (70 or 100 pages, with 3 holes, but pockets are not necessary) be sure notebook will clip into binder
- 3 Folders with holes and horizontal pockets, (1 for homework, 1 for computer and 1 for Religion)
- 2 Black marble composition books with stiff cover (100 pages)
- 2 Packages of #2 *sharpened* pencils with erasers. (We prefer that you have pencils with erasers rather than a separate eraser. No mechanical pencils, please.)
- 1 Packages red ballpoint pens to be used for correcting work (Papermate brand, erasable pen)
- 1 Plastic lunch box or soft sided, insulated lunch box with handle (to store supplies; these boxes are deep enough to keep all supplies, including glue, scissors, and writing tools. They also have sturdier clasps than traditional pencil boxes.) Suggested size 4"x 6 ½"x 8 1/2".
- 1 Pair of "children's scissors"
- 1 small 8 pack of thin-line, felt-tipped markers
- 1 12-pack of colored pencils
- 1 Box of crayons (no more than 24 are needed)
- 2 - 4 oz. white glue
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels for classroom use
- 1 container of Clorox disinfectant wipes
- 1 new white T-shirt that amply fits you. We will put an "iron-on" picture on the shirt front, and afterward you can use it for a sleep shirt, etc. This can be a boy's white, crew neck T-shirt for both boys and girls. *Put your name on the inside label or neck band.*(Pattern transfers best on 50%cotton, 50% poly shirt, if you can find it. Try Michael's Craft Store.)
- 2 book socks
- 1 box of quart size plastic Ziploc bags
- 5 tab dividers for binder
- Post it Notes 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 400 count

Fourth Grade Supply List

- 1 not more than 2 – 2 ½ inch zipper binder
- 2 one-inch flexible plastic three-ring notebooks (Reading & Language)
- Notebook paper (***wide rule***) – 2 packages – **do not open the package**
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 black super-fine tipped Sharpies (or other permanent) marker
- 1 box #2 pencils with erasers (***NO MECHANICAL PENCILS, ERASABLE PENS OR LIQUID PENCILS***)
- 1 box crayons - no more than 12 in a box
- Soft Sided Zippered Rectangular lunch box (for supplies)
- 1 package fine tip markers (no more than 8)
- 1 package colored pencils (no more than 12)
- 3 highlighters
- 3 spiral notebooks with holes (8"x11") for homework and vocabulary
- 1 spiral notebook with spiral on top! (8 ½ x 11)
- 2 pocket folders with holes to put in binders
- 1 pocket folder with fasteners for Social Studies
- 3 packages of red ballpoint pens for correcting papers
- 1 Mead composition notebook (100 pages sewn binding) – will be recovered
- 1 Packages of large colored 4x6 index cards
- 2 rolls of paper towels – Boys only
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 2 glue sticks
- 3 notebook dividers – write-on tabs only, and **not** with pockets (paper, not plastic)
- cap erasers (package of 40)

- 1 USB flash drive (1 GB memory)
